A. His work would consist of:

1. Ending sin, or bringing forgiveness
2. Making reconciliation
3. Bringing in everlasting righteousness
4. Sealing up vision and prophecy
5. Anointing the Most Holy

B. Ample New Testament evidence

224. Timing of the Messiah – Dan 9.25

A. The countdown began with the rebuilding of Jerusalem, not the temple.

B. Days equal years, hence a week a unit of seven years.

1. From the beginning of 70 weeks
2. to the mid-point of the 70th week
 - a) there are 486.5 years.
 - b) The command was issued in 457 BC.

(1) $475 + 486.5 = 29.5$

(2) Jesus died in AD 30.

(a) His ministry lasted for 3.5 years.

(b) He began in AD 26.
